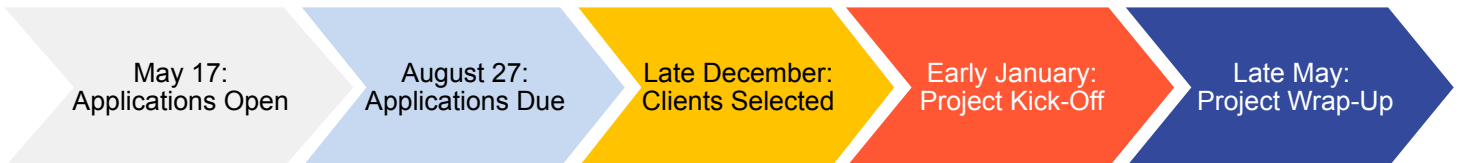

What Makes a Successful Project?

- Addresses a high-priority strategic challenge facing the organization
- Tight project scope with well-defined goals and deliverables
- Can be completed in the timeframe
- Senior staff and key board members can dedicate time and attention to the project
- Not focused on fundraising or board governance
- Doesn't require specialized industry knowledge

Applicant Eligibility

- 501(c)(3) nonprofit status
- Stable, established organization with demonstrated need
- Located in greater Boston area
- Established board of directors
- Approximate annual budget between \$500,000 and \$5 million
- Full-time paid Executive Director and a minimum of three full time staff
